FOUR INVESTMENT AREAS



INNOVATIVE SCHOOLS

Support the creation of new innovative public schools and learning environments



LEARNING SOLUTIONS

Invest in tools, content, models and services that effectively and equitably support student learning



DIVERSE LEADERS

Increase leader and teacher diversity; support parent advocacy; and invest in equity capacity builders



RACIAL EQUITY

Increase racial equity in education beyond our existing investment areas through participatory grantmaking

NewSchools supports tools, content, and models that increase equity by accelerating positive outcomes for Black, Latino, and low-income students.



Literacy is key driver of equity, empowerment, and learning



Demand for new types of literacy solutions

- Too many literacy learning experiences are neither <u>culturally responsive</u> nor <u>aligned with research</u>
- COVID-19 has had disproportionate effects on historically underserved students, especially in regard to <u>literacy development</u>
- ESSER funding can align spending power with equity-centered solutions
- Significant <u>investment capital is available</u>, yet racially diverse leaders are being <u>structurally excluded</u> from funding pathways



Building a portfolio of early-stage, equity-centered solutions

By the numbers...

In 2021, we invested \$2m in 10 literacy solutions.

1/3 leaders identify as Black or Latino; 3/4 as people of color; 56% as female or nonbinary

70% of organizations are led by former educators; 50% are receiving first-ever external investment **Learning Solutions literacy portfolio**

The Literacy Architects develop Literacy Masterminds, a series of virtual learning cycles through which teachers receive step-by-step guidance on implementing evidence-based reading practices aligned with their school's curriculum.

Words Liive offers The Opus, an application which integrates music, via song lyrics, into reading and writing assignments alongside auto-generated, comprehensive supplemental materials.



Leveraging the power of 1-1 or small group literacy instruction

Readlee

Readlee is an independent reading platform that uses AI to measure and report data such as accuracy, vocabulary, pace, and text completion.

Evision Academy Programs offers a Braille-based literacy program to support blind and visually limited learners, in both public and homeschool settings.
