Challenges with the Current System

CONTINUOUS IMPROVEMENT INFRASTRUCTURE

- 1) Organizational culture and incentives do not support continuous learning and improvement.
- 2) The structures and conditions needed to support continuous learning are not adequately developed.

R&D INFRASTRUCTURE

- 3) Funding for R&D in education is low, especially on the development side.
- 4) Approaches to knowledge creation are not tailored to policy and practice needs.
- 5) The field lacks commonly agreed-upon evidence standards and a common vocabulary.
- 6) Approaches to diffusing knowledge do not reflect how stakeholders acquire and use information.

DATA INFRASTRUCTURE

7) The culture of data use needs to be strengthened, and concerns about data privacy and security need to be addressed.




In times of crisis, knowledge must flow freely and quickly. The COVID-19 pandemic created just such a crisis in K-12 education.
