

A Personalized Learning Axiom

Helping educators become more effective in their ability to personalize their instructional practices for every learner, understand each child's history as it evolves, and then teach to and empower the whole child is an imperative for educational research.

The "Outliers"

A statistical observation that is markedly different in value from the others of the sample



The "Outliers"

We cannot handle outliers by erasing them from the story .





The "Outliers"

Be curious about their story and the history that contextualizes their experiences.



Personalized Learning Research Pathway

RESEARCH STAGE I

- Lay a theoretical foundation
- Design and pilot measures
- Observe student and adult behavior
- Describe classroom characteristics
- Tell "life" stories

RESEARCH STAGE 2

- Investigate measurement validity
- Examine environments
- Study empirical relationships
- Tell "life" stories

RESEARCH STAGE 3

- Study causal relationships
- Examine longitudinal trends
- Tell "life" stories

Stage 1 Research

K12 Remote Learning, Race, and Innovation (LEAP Innovations, 2020-2021)

The purpose of this mixed-methods study is to deconstruct the dominant narrative that shrouds African-American school communities' implementation of remote learning in classic deficit rhetoric: "vulnerable," "lagging," and "at-risk." We will document the strengths and successes of remote learning, along with the needs that have arisen, within predominantly African-American school communities that are practicing personalized learning.
